


#### Overall QHE Model




#### **Assumptions:**

- Three trophic levels
- Top-down control in systems pre-20th century
- When predator control weakens carrying capacity decreases over time
  - Changes structure & species composition
  - Less palatable & more resilient species increase in dominance
- Human hunting is primary predation component

#### To achieve its mission, CSI has five components:

**Partnership Council** - leadership, coordination, funding, monitoring.

<u>Cooperative Conservation Fund</u> strategic, landscape-level habitat restoration investments within the sagebrush biome.

<u>Conservation Credit Exchange</u> facilitate the marketing of tradable conservation credits of fixed ecological value

<u>Body of Incentives</u> to encourage conservation participation in the Cooperative Sagebrush Initiative and investment in the Cooperative Conservation Fund.

<u>Monitoring and Assessment Program</u> audit projects & funds and assess program performance

**Specifically:** The Cooperative Sagebrush Initiative is established for the purpose of recovering the western sagebrush-steppe biome

- •through a collaborative, coordinated, and costeffective public-private partnership
- •built upon incentives for landowners, local communities, and private industry to invest in habitat restoration and other conservation actions
- •resulting in long-term, verifiable recovery of the greater sage-grouse and improvement of other species of concern in the sagebrush range.



#### Goals:

- Preclude the need to list sage-grouse under the Endangered Species Act
- Assure no net loss of important sagesteppe habitat
- Establish an effective system of mitigation practices and conservation credits to facilitate offsite mitigation







# Partnership Failures: Causes First Set

- o Goals unclear Why should we?
- Misaligned aims
- Unfamiliar people
- Distance cultural
- Distance geographic
- Competition \$, not cooperation
- o "Catastrophism"
- Not crediting others



# Partnership Failures: Causes Second Set

- Process rejected
- Inadequate buy-in
- Meetings not run well
- Damage done to public agencies
- o Too big, unwieldy, would be better as a coalition?
- Corruption
- Too much money in the project, little to no innovation
