# Rights-Of-Way in Texas

RRC: 466,623 miles of pipelines

TXDOT: 79,000 miles of roads

10,384 miles of railway

ERCOT: 38,000 miles of transmission lines

~594,007 miles

594,007 miles x ~200 ft (.038 mile) = 22,500 sq. miles or
