Seed Collection

- Identify target species
- Train volunteers
- Build/promote a network
- Collect regionally appropriate seed



Plant Grow Out

- Divert a portion of cleaned seed for grow out of live plants as XL plugs

- Organize by species, zone, state

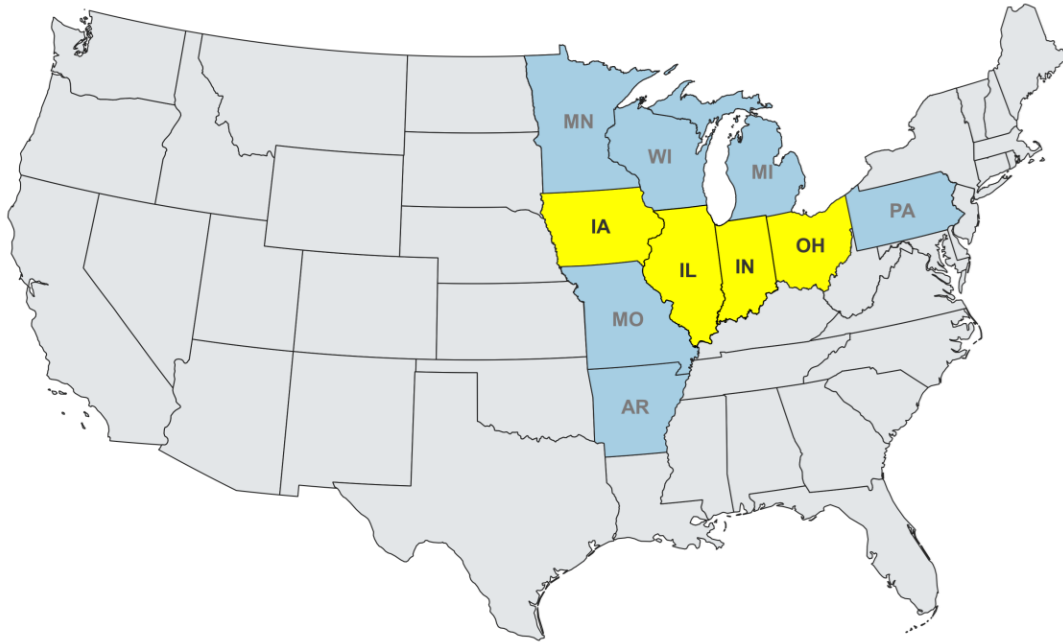


Plant Awards
