FOCUS: Capacity building, facilitate community organization and participation, promote inter-community governance, and develop strategic links for environmental conservation.

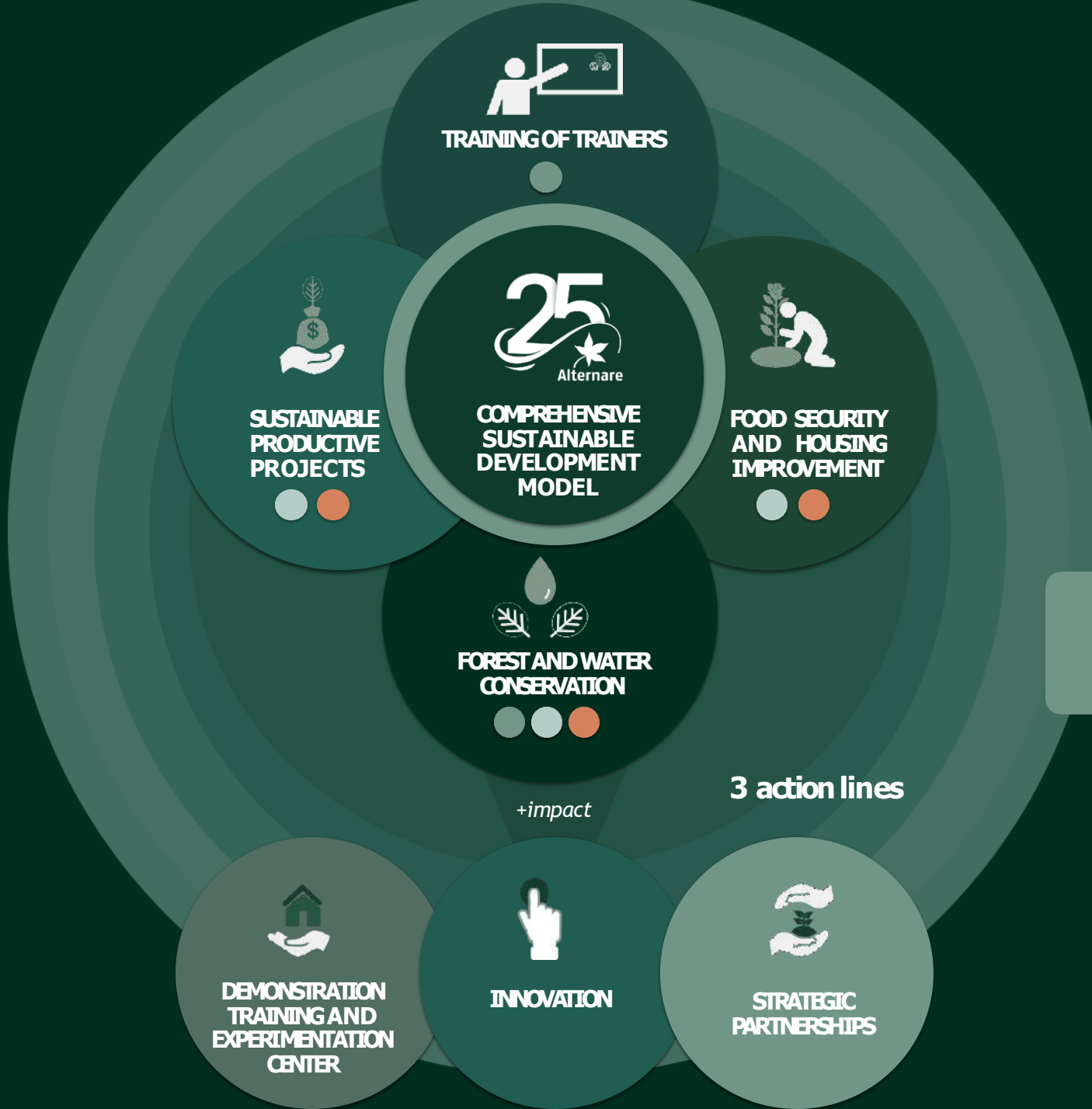
